The King riding on a donkey

Have you been in a time when things are going well and they go down all of a sudden? Such was the case with Jesus on the last week of His life. Started out on a high note, things were going well, people singing his praises on the city streets. Somewhere close to the end of the week everything fell to the ground.

Jesus rides on the cloaks because that is symbolic of what happened in the Old testament too. When Jehu was coronated as King (2 Kings 9:13) they quickly took their cloaks and spread them under Him on the bare steps. When Solomon was coronated as King they took palm branches and laid them on the street and allowed Him to ride on the palm branches. So Jesus is in the tradition of the Kings of the Old Testament. Jesus did all of this not to showcase Himself but to showcase the scriptures.
